**Yellowknife, Northwest Territories** – An incident occurred around 3:30 pm on June 15, 2017 where a child was struck by a vehicle in the parking lot at Mildred Hall School.

The child was injured and was sent to Stanton Territorial Hospital for medical treatment and later transferred to Edmonton for further treatment. On behalf of YK1 and everyone at Mildred Hall, I want to express our deep concern for this child and family, as well as for all classmates and the entire school.

Our thoughts are with our young student as we hope for a speedy recovery. The school reported the matter to the RCMP and they are conducting an investigation.

All school staff are expected to cooperate fully with the police investigation and to provide any information they may have that could assist in this process. We will provide further public updates when appropriate. For now, we will focus our thoughts on supporting this child and the family of this young person.
